

## ORDER

---

Appellant has filed a notice of appeal from the trial court's order denying Appellant's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Appellant also alleges he should be permitted to file his complaint and pay the circuit court filing fee in installments using his inmate trust account.

Because Appellant has failed to pay the notice of appeal filing fee as required by Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, this appeal is dismissed. However, we remand this matter to the circuit court for consideration of whether Appellant should be permitted to file his action and make payments from his inmate trust account as provided in section 24-27-100 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (2007).<sup>1</sup>
