MOTION TO REINSTATE APPEAL

The undersigned counsel petitions the Court to reinstate the direct appeal of Kemontee Devonta Blocker. In support of this petition, counsel would respectfully show the Court that:

1. Trial counsel served and filed the notice of intent to appeal on May 21, 2024.
2. After receiving notification that a notice of appeal was filed, the Office of Appellate Defense contacted trial counsel to obtain the dates of appellant's trial to order the transcript.
3. When receiving the trial dates from trial counsel recently in order to request the necessary transcripts for this appeal, undersigned counsel's staff was notified by trial counsel that appellant had an upcoming hearing date for his post-trial motions that this office was not previously aware had been filed. Undersigned counsel later learned that these post-trial motions were heard by the trial judge on Monday, July 8, 2024, and denied that same day.

4. On Wednesday, July 10, 2024, this Court dismissed the present appeal due to the failure of appellant to order the transcript as provided in Rule 207, SCACR.


5. The notice of intent to appeal was served on the solicitor on May 17, 2024, and filed with this Court on May 21, 2024, and the post-trial motions were filed in the lower court on May 21, 2024. Therefore, the lower court was without jurisdiction to hear the post-trial motions on July 8, 2024 since appellant's appeal was pending before this Court and no order remanding this case to the lower court to hear and rule on the post-trial motions was sought or issued, nor was this appeal dismissed without prejudice in order for the lower court to have jurisdiction to hear these post-trial motions. See Hudson v. Hudson, 290 S.C. 215, 349 S.E.2d 341 (1986). Therefore, the post-trial motions, the hearing on those post-trial motions, and the order denying them were each a nullity. Cf. State v. Funderburk, 259 S.C. 256, 191 S.E.2d 520 (1972).

6. The Division of Appellate Defense did not order the transcript in this case due to confusion when staff learned of the pending post-trial motions. However, it is now apparent the lower court was without jurisdiction to hear those post-trial motions because Appellant Blocker's timely served and filed appeal was pending in this Court. Therefore, if this Court reinstates appellant's appeal, the interests of justice will respectfully be served, and this appeal will be allowed to proceed since it was timely served and filed. Further, the transcripts required for this appeal have now been ordered as evidenced by Exhibit A, attached to this motion to reinstate.

7. Undersigned counsel understands the Office of the Attorney General takes no position on this motion.

WHEREFORE, undersigned counsel respectfully requests that the direct appeal for Kemontee Devonta Blocker be reinstated.


