## ORDER

---

On March 4, 2024, Appellant filed a notice of appeal challenging an order filed in the circuit court on January 30, 2024. On March 11, 2024, Appellant filed an amended notice of appeal challenging an order filed in the circuit court on February 12, 2024. On March 18, 2024, Appellant filed a second amended notice of appeal challenging an order filed in the circuit court on February 16, 2024. On June 7, 2024, this court sent a letter to Appellant explaining she must file and serve a motion to amend her notice of appeal. On June 17, 2024, Appellant filed a motion for reconsideration of our June 7 letter. On July 26, 2024, this court sent a letter to Appellant stating no action would be taken on her motion for reconsideration and allowing her appeal to proceed as filed at this time.<sup>1</sup>

On August 5, 2024, Appellant moved for reconsideration of this court's July 26 letter. After careful consideration, we take no action on Appellant's motion for reconsideration. *See* Rule 221(c), SCACR ("The appellate court will not entertain petitions for rehearing on a motion or petition unless the action of the court on the

<sup>1</sup> This letter also explained Appellant must provide proof of having ordered the transcript. Appellant's August 5 motion stated she had provided proof of ordering the transcript. On March 4, 2024, Appellant provided this court with a copy of a letter in which she ordered a transcript from a hearing on February 6, 2024. Based upon Appellant's representation in her August 5 motion, this court assumes the February 6, 2024 transcript is the only transcript necessary to perfect the appeal.

motion or petition has the effect of dismissing or finally deciding a party's appeal."). We take this opportunity to note our July 26 letter explained Appellant's appeal, including her amended notice of appeal and second amended notice of appeal, would be allowed to proceed at this time.
