ORDER

On August 2, 2024, Appellant moved to strike the initial briefs filed by Respondents South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce (SCDEW) and Wells Fargo & Company, Inc. (Wells Fargo). Respondents filed returns, opposing Appellant's motion. Respondent SCDEW also asked this court to dismiss Appellant's appeal as a sanction for filing frivolous and repetitive motions. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion to strike and Respondent SCDEW's request for sanctions.

On August 2, 2024, Appellant also moved this court to compel Respondents to provide her with surveillance video footage from February 2, 2023. Respondent SCDEW filed a return opposing Appellant's motion to compel. It is undisputed surveillance video footage was not presented to the Administrative Law Court. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion to compel. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The [r]ecord shall not, however, include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal.").

Finally, the motion to substitute Shahin Vafai as counsel for Respondent Wells Fargo is granted. Andreas J. Mosby is relieved as counsel for Respondent Wells Fargo.
