

ORDER

On July 12, 2024, we issued an order holding this appeal in abeyance for ninety days as requested by Appellant due to Appellant's poor health. On July 31, 2024, Respondent filed a motion to dismiss this appeal, stating Appellant failed to serve her with the motion to hold the appeal in abeyance and asserting that Appellant is not in poor health because he "is mobile, able to attend to his daily activities of living, [and] able to write and submit requests for extensions of time." Appellant filed a return, stating he served Appellant and that he remains in poor health. After careful consideration of the filings, we deny Respondent's motion to dismiss. This appeal remains in abeyance until the expiration of the ninety-day period provided in our July 12, 2024 order at which time Appellant must serve and file the amended record on appeal. Failure to comply will result in dismissal of this appeal.
