
The Record on Appeal filed by Appellants is not in compliance with Rule 210 of the Appellate Court Rules. Rule 210(c) mandates a specific sequence in ordering the documents contained within the Record on Appeal and requires that pages be numbered consecutively beginning with the index. The Record on Appeal at issue does not contain an index and thus the page numbering necessarily does not begin thereon. Furthermore, the sequencing of the documents present therein is also not in conformity with Rule 210(c). It further does not contain the information as to attorney and witness designations on deposition pages.
