Opposing counsel has graciously consented to all requests through September 30, 2024. In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following:

Respondent's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter is due Monday, September 16, 2024, as per this Court's Order dated August 13, 2024, granting Respondent's third extension request. The undersigned attorney for the Respondent has had a number of state and federal matters to attend to since August 2024. Specifically,

5. Counsel completed and filed the Return and Memorandum in Support of Summary Judgment in the matter of Gary A. White, Jr. v. Director Bryan Stirling, C/A 0:24-cv-2595-DCN-SVH, on September 9, 2024, a matter pending in the District Court;
6. Counsel is working on the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter due September 18, 2024 in the case of The State v. Bradley Wayne Walker, Appellate Case No. 2023-000139, a matter pending in this Court and on Fifth Extension;




