APPELLANTS' EMERGENCY REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

On July 10, 2024, this Court filed its Unpublished Opinion No. 24-UP-254. By Order of this Court dated July 23, 2024, the current deadline for filing a petition for rehearing is September 16, 2024. Pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, Appellants, by and through their undersigned counsel, hereby respectfully request an extension of ten (10) days' time for Appellants to petition for rehearing of this matter, until September 26, 2024.

The undersigned counsel states that there are extraordinary circumstances that

require this request. Shortly before this Court's Opinion was filed, the undersigned's elderly father began what has been a devastating decline in his health and well-being. He has dementia, and he lives alone in Virginia. Among other things, due to his mental difficulties, he fell victim to a scam that led him to send \$650,000 in checks to complete strangers. Many of those checks were cashed. The undersigned has been working constantly with his medical providers, the police and social services departments in Richmond, and his banks, to try to get him the help he needs. This has required an extraordinary amount of time and effort, and the undersigned has fallen behind at work.

Although the undersigned had set aside September 12-16 to draft the Petition for Rehearing in this matter, her father had a series of crises beginning on Thursday, which culminated over the weekend in a possible stroke – which required police and emergency personnel to be dispatched to his home. The undersigned is travelling to Richmond at the time of this filing, because it is likely he will be admitted to the hospital.

Because of these extraordinary, extenuating circumstances, Appellants respectfully ask for a third extension in which to file the Petition for Rehearing in this appeal. Appellants respectfully ask that this Court would grant them until September 26, 2024 to file their Petition for Rehearing.
