This matter came before this Court on Plaintiff's Motion to Reconsider, pursuant to SCRC P 52 and 59, this Court's findings arising from a bench trial conducted on December 18-20, 2019. At trial, the Court heard from eight (8) fact witnesses, and both sides provided voluminous evidentiary exhibits. After completion of the trial, both parties obtained the trial testimony transcript, and cited to the record in their proposed orders submitted to this Court.
