We are in receipt of a copy of the Court's correspondence directed to the Appellant, dated September 6, 2024, regarding his filing of an amended appellant's brief without a motion to amend. As Counsel for the Respondents, we have no objection to the amended filing; however, we write seeking clarification regarding the deadline for our initial brief and designations in light of the series of confusing filings and appellate documents filed and/or served by this pro se Appellant.


The Appellant filed and served a Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal by U.S. Mail on June 28, 2024, without filing a brief. The Appellant thereafter served a brief on Respondent by U.S. Mail on July 24, 2024; however, it does not appear that this brief was ever filed with the Court of Appeals. Instead, the Appellant filed a different version of his brief which was clocked as received by the Court on August 14, 2024. The Appellant then filed and served yet another brief on August 19, 2024 which is identified on C-Track as an updated/corrected/amended brief. It appears that the Court's letter is directed to the August 19<sup>th</sup> brief.

We would respectfully ask the Court to advise if the deadline for the Respondents' initial brief and designation is being held in abeyance pending a decision on whether the amended/corrected brief will be accepted, or in the alternative, whether the Respondents must make a formal motion to hold the briefing schedule in abeyance until there is a decision on whether the amended appellant's brief will be accepted.

Thank you for your attention to this inquiry and we await further direction from the Court.
