**Narrative:**

On September 22, 2023, at approximately 1050 hours, Mental Health Agent Dylan French was conducting a home visit progress audit with Mr. Kadidas Gossett at his residence of [REDACTED]. Upon arriving at the residence, Agent observed a small plastic bag containing a green leafy substance sitting on the front porch by the front door. Agent asked the offender if the substance was his and he advised that it was not. Agent then called Mental Health Supervisor Ramsey who instructed Agent to drug test the offender and have the offender flush the substance down the toilet on body camera. Agent drug tested the offender which came back negative for all substances. Agent then spoke with Mr. Gossett's brother, identified as [REDACTED], and advised him that the narcotics would be disposed of. Mr. Gossett flushed the substance down the toilet on Agent's body camera. Agent advised offender to be careful who he spends his time with and to think about moving into his own residence. Mr. Gossett advised that he would. Nothing further.



Personally appeared before me, one Dylan French, who, first being duly sworn, deposes and says that KADIDAS REACO SENTELL GOSSETT did within this County and State on the 23 day of January, 2024, violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particulars:


**DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE:**

The offender has violated conditions 1, 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, Special Conditions of the standard Department conditions associated with Section 24-21-430. The offender has also violated special conditions imposed by the General Sessions Court per order dated June 16, 2022. This warrant or citation is issued pursuant to section 24-21-450 or 300.

The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

By being in possession of a firearm as evidenced by Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office Incident Report # 23110953 on 11/20/2023, which stated that offender was arrested for possession of pistol by violent felon and unlawful carry of a pistol due to Spartanburg County Deputy locating a Glock 19 bearing serial #BLCH664 on offender's waist band. By being in possession of a firearm as evidenced by Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office Incident Report # 24010767 on 01/17/2024, which stated offender was arrested for a home detention violation and felon in possession of a firearm due to being in the presence of an unsecured firearm in his residence according to Corporal Pretlove and Sergeant Clevenger of the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office who located a Glock 9mm pistol under a pillow in a back bedroom along with a .40 caliber Glock pistol extended capacity magazine in a backpack while conducting a home detention compliance check, during which, the offender admitted that the firearm belonged to him after being advised of his miranda rights. By failing to notify supervising agent of arrest by the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office on 11/20/2023 during home visit progress audit on 12/06/2023. By failing to abide by home detention contract signed by offender as a condition of offender's bond from arrest in November of 2023 as evidenced by Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office Incident Report # 24010767 in which offender was arrested by the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office for a home detention violation. By making untruthful report to supervising agent during home visit progress audit on 12/06/2023 that offender had not had



STANDARD CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

1. I shall report in person to the South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services' office on the day of my sentencing or release, and as instructed by the Department; and I shall make complete and truthful reports to the Agent.
2. I shall not change my residence or employment without the consent of my Agent. Further, I shall allow my Agent to visit me in my home, at my place of employment, or elsewhere, at any time.
3. I shall not use controlled substances, except when properly prescribed by a licensed physician, nor consume alcoholic beverages to excess, nor enter establishments whose primary business is the sale and drinking of alcoholic beverages. Further, I shall submit to a urinalysis, blood test or provide forensic evidence when instructed by Agents of the Department, and I agree that any of these test results may be used as evidence in any hearing for the violation of the conditions of my supervision.
4. I shall not possess or purchase any firearms or other dangerous weapons, and I shall not associate with any person who has a criminal record, or any other person whom my Agent has instructed me to avoid.
5. I shall work diligently at a lawful occupation. Further, I shall notify my Agent if I become unemployed.
6. I shall not violate any Federal, State, or Local Law, and I shall immediately contact my Agent if I am ever arrested or questioned by a law enforcement official for any reason whatsoever.
7. I shall pay a supervision fee and any other fees as determined by the Department.
8. I shall not leave the State without permission from my Agent. Further, if I am ever arrested in another state for violating these conditions, I hereby irrevocably waive all extradition rights I may otherwise have been entitled to and agree to return to South Carolina when directed by my Agent, the Court or by a warrant.
9. I shall obey all conditions of supervision set forth in this order including the payment of fines, restitution or other payments, and the service of any period of incarceration.
10. I shall follow the advice and instructions of my Agent and I agree to comply with any further conditions imposed by the Department or its Agents.
11. I agree to pay restitution and a statutory collection fee payable to the Department of Probation, Parole, and Pardon Services as directed by Agents of the Department. (20% collection fee charged)
12. Unless I was convicted of or pled guilty or nolo contendere to a Class C misdemeanor or an unclassified misdemeanor that carries a term of imprisonment of not more than one year, I shall be subject to a search or seizure, without a search warrant, based on reasonable suspicions, of my person, any vehicle I own or am driving, and any of my possessions by: (1) any probation agent employed by the Department; or (2) any other law enforcement officer.




