Dear Honorable Judges of the South Carolina Court of Appeals,

I, Russell Lewis Walker, respectfully request leave of court to file a Rule 60 motion for relief from judgment in the Circuit Court. This motion is made pursuant to Rule 60 of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure, which allows for relief from a final judgment, order, or proceeding under certain circumstances.

The grounds for this motion are as follows:

- **Lack of Notice and Opportunity to Be Heard****: I was not given notice or an opportunity to be heard before the restraining order was issued, violating my due process rights.
- **Failure to Execute Warrants****: Multiple arrest warrants were issued but not executed, leaving me unaware of the legal actions against me.
- **Improper Bond Revocation****: My bond was revoked without notice, a written motion, or a scheduled hearing, violating S.C. Code Ann. § 17-15-55(8)(1).
- **No Preliminary Hearing****: I was never given a preliminary hearing for the 2021 charges, so jurisdiction had not transferred from the Magistrate Court to the Court of General Sessions, as per S.C. Code Ann. § 22-5-320.
- **No Grand Jury Indictment****: The State failed to obtain a Grand Jury indictment for the charges, a necessary step to correct the jurisdictional defect.
- **Ex-Parte Bond Revocation Hearing****: The Assistant Solicitor initiated an ex-parte bond revocation hearing without my presence, leading to my false arrest and false imprisonment.
- **No Charges at Time of Bond Revocation****: I had no charges against me at the time my imaginary no-bond, bond was revoked, making the revocation improper.
- **Coercion to Accept Plea Deal****: I was pressured into accepting a plea deal under the threat of prolonged incarceration and additional indictments.
- **Gag Order****: The gag order issued by the Chief Justice on May 23, 2019, restricts my ability to communicate effectively with the court system of this state.

Given these circumstances, I respectfully request that the Court grant me leave to file a Rule 60 motion for relief from judgment in the Circuit Court. I believe that justice requires the reconsideration of the judgment in light of the procedural and substantive errors outlined above.

I certify that all of these matters are relevant, and necessary to overcome an error in law and in addition doesn't contain any matter irrelevant to this appeal.

AFFIDAVIT OF Russell Lewis Walker

I, Russell Lewis Walker, being duly sworn, depose and say:

1. I am the appellant in the case number 2024-000643 currently before the South Carolina Court of Appeals.
2. I am seeking leave of court to file a Rule 60 motion for relief from judgment in the Circuit Court.
3. The grounds for my motion are as follows:
 - a. I was not given notice or an opportunity to be heard before the judge sua sponte issued a permanent restraining order against me violating my due process rights, and imposing a lifetime firearms ban. I have attached a copy of the permanent restraining order, texts between my attorney and I about the restraining order and an amended restraining order allegedly filed that I believe is fake or regardless lacking force and effect, the attachment is marked "Exhibit 1, page 1, of 8 pages" and is incorporated herein by reference.
 - b. Civil Rights violated by Failure to Execute Warrants: Multiple arrest warrants were issued but not executed, pursuant to duty required under S.C. Code Ann. § 16-5-40, leaving me unaware of the legal actions against me. I have attached copies of 3 warrants including a felony warrant issued but not executed for 2 weeks, marked "Exhibit 2, page 1 of 3 pages" and is incorporated herein by reference.

c. **Improper Bond Revocation:** My bond was revoked without notice, a written motion, or a scheduled hearing, violating S.C. Code Ann. § 17-15-55(B)(1)

d. **No Preliminary Hearing:** I was never given a preliminary hearing for the 2021 charges, so jurisdiction had not transferred from the Magistrate Court to the Court of General Sessions, as per S.C. Code Ann. § 22-5-320, and will be requesting information from the Edgefield Magistrate and Bond Court. I have attached a copy of the case history for each of the warrant copies referenced in the preceding paragraph, which show preliminary hearing was requested 1 day after arrest, the same being marked "Exhibit 3, page 1 of 3 pages" and is incorporated herein by reference.

e. **No Grand Jury Indictment:** The State failed to obtain a Grand Jury indictment for the charges, which was a necessary step to correct the jurisdictional defect described in the preceding paragraph.

f. **Ex-Parte Bond Revocation Hearing:** The Assistant Solicitor initiated an ex-parte bond revocation hearing without my presence, leading to my false arrest and false imprisonment. I have attached a copy of the trial judge's order that appeared for the first time in May of 2024, when Derek Chizzora went to the McCormick County Detention Center to pick it up from Captain Bernice Anderson, Jail Administrator. I have marked it "Exhibit 4" and it is incorporated herein by reference.

g. **No Charges at Time of Bond Revocation:** I was arrested without a warrant or charges because all prior charges had been *nolle prosequi* and there were no warrants or indictments for the matters before the court and so bond to revoke, my imaginary bond was revoked, making the revocation improper, but the false imprisonment was not imaginary nor were the threats and coercion while I was under duress that followed.

h. **Coercion to Accept Plea Deal:** I was pressured into accepting a plea deal while under duress with the threat of further duress by prolonged incarceration and additional indictments.


i. **Unconstitutional violation of 6th and 14th amendment to the US Const. Gag Order:** The Supreme Court of South Carolina gag order issued by the Chief Justice on May 23, 2019, restricting my ability to communicate effectively with the court system of this state. I have attached a copy of the Supreme Court Order and letters from the Edgefield County Clerk of Court relying on that order marked "Exhibit 5, page 1 of 4 pages" and it is incorporated herein by reference.

j. **Yes but No:** This court informed that attorney filed Anders Brief and motion to be relieved July 19, 2024, advised I must proceed pro se; I proceeded pro se filing motion to extend the time to file motions and prepare a pro se brief, and another motion to correct the hearing transcript, this Court of Appeals granted the motion to extend time but returned the motion to correct the transcript, stating it could not be accepted because I had an attorney when I do not have an attorney, as this Court advised me the appellate attorney filed a motion to be relieved, and that I must proceed pro se. I have attached a copy of letters, Order, and motions marked "Exhibit 6, page 1 of 10 pages" and it is incorporated herein by reference.

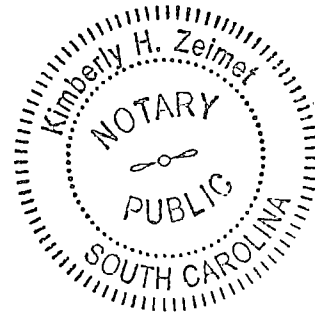

I am extremely happy about it myself. When they got notice of the appeal I knew they were going to ask me about it. So without going in a great detail I told them one of the major concerns was the firearm restriction. I convinced fender to allow me to discuss it with the judge and apparently neither the judge or the solicitor were aware that those boxes were checked. When they ran the form for the restraining order apparently the boxes had already been checked and no one caught it. Fender agreed in the judge acknowledged that there was never an intention or an agreement as part of the plea to have your firearm right restricted so the judge amended the order like I said I should have an official clock copy of it tomorrow and will spread it around.

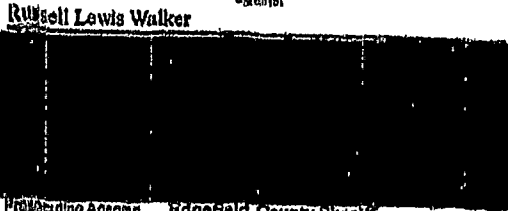



In the matter of Russell L. Walker

I find that Respondent's conduct during the pendency of the above-referenced matters has been inappropriate toward the courts of this State, its officers, and employees. On multiple occasions, Respondent has attempted to engage in ex parte communications with multiple Family Court Judges across the State through the use of email and has left inappropriate and abusive messages on judicial voicemails.

It is the duty of this Court to maintain the integrity of the court system in this State; it is also the duty of this Court to protect the rights of all persons, including Respondent, to meaningful access to the courts of this State. In striking that balance, this Court finds it appropriate to issue this order to clarify Respondent's rights and responsibilities.

The following guidelines set forth Respondent's rights and responsibilities in connection with the courts of this State, including all officers and employees of the South Carolina court system.

- (1) Except as otherwise provided in this order, Respondent may not contact any judge, justice, law clerk, clerk of court, administrative assistant or secretary, or any other officer or employee of the United Judicial System in person, in writing, or by mail, telephone, fax, e-mail, or any other form of electronic communication. Instead, if it is necessary for Respondent to contact an officer or employee of the Judicial System outside a scheduled hearing or trial, that contact shall be made in writing and shall be filed


with the appropriate clerk of court by an attorney licensed to practice law in South Carolina, or by Respondent if he is proceeding *pro se*.

- (2) All *pro se* filings shall be made in writing and shall either be hand-delivered or mailed in the United States Mail to the clerk of court. Respondent shall not send filings to the clerk of court by fax, e-mail, or any other form of electronic communication. All *pro se* submissions of Respondent are subject to law, including Rule 11, SCRPC, requiring that all submissions be made in good faith and not for the purpose of delay, harassment, or the injection of irrelevant matter into the proceedings.

Neither this order nor the prior orders or opinions of this Court shall have any impact on actions previously taken in connection with Respondent. Further, nothing in this order shall be construed as precluding the lower courts from placing additional restrictions on Respondent if he engages in frivolous, disruptive, or inappropriate conduct or filings.

These restrictions shall apply to the matters listed above as well as any future litigation to which Respondent is a party.

Respondent is warned that a violation of the restrictions contained in this order may result in contempt proceedings being initiated against him.



WHEREFORE, the appellant respectfully requests that this Court order the following:

- a) Direct the court reporter to correct the identified errors and omissions.
- b) Allow the appellant access to the audio recordings of the trial proceedings to verify the accuracy of the transcript.
- c) Require the court reporter to sign and certify the corrected transcript.


