Dear Ms.Kitchings,

I am writing you today with the concerns of my prevailing wages case in the Court of Appeals. I filed my notice of Appeal on 6/21/2024. On 6/28/2024 I received a letter from you stating that my notice of Appeal had a few deficiencies . I quickly corrected those deficiencies. A few weeks after I did not get any notice from you so I filed my brief on 7/15/2024. On 7/22/2024 I received a copy of my brief from the Court of Appeals, stamped that your officer received the brief on 7/17/2024.

Ms.Kitchings, I filed all documents in a timely manner but has not received any notifications from the Court of Appeals. I was expecting some type of notice concerning my case. It has been over (2) two months since I filed my brief with the Court of Appeals.

On 8/16/2024, (30) thirty days after filing my brief I had a visit from an outside attorney. His name is Mr.Todd Darwin. Mr.Darwin is the attorney hired by the Department I assume. Mr.Durwin has come to Livesay with offers to inmates concerning their prevailing wages case. Mr.Durwin, on 8/16/2024 came to me with an offer of \$56,000.00 for prevailing wages. I quickly signed several documents that stated I was in agreement with the offer of \$56,000.00, and the money would be deposited in my cooper account within 10 to 30 days. This (30) day waiting period has passed and no offer of the \$56,000.00 has been deposited in my account. (Several inmates who signed those same documents 48 hours before I signed has received their money within (10) working days. This has left me with great concerns. I have not received not one correspondent from the Court of Appeals. Knowing what I know from other inmates I had assume that the Department has made some kind of deal with the Court of Appeals. (Meaning that the Department had advise the Court of Appeals they had decided to pay the prevailing wages money) And that was the reason the Court of Appeals had not sent me any correspondent .

Seeing now that I have not received the \$56,000.00 I would like to know what

is going on with my case. I have done all I could do concerning my case. I filed all documents on time. The Court of Appeals did not respond to me brief within a timely manner. The Department did not deposit my \$56,000.00 prevailing wages money within the (30) days.

Ms.Kitchings, if it be possible could you please let me know what is going on with my case. I have not received any correspondent from the Court of Appeals. I have this attorney who works for the Department offering me \$56,000.00 but has not deposit the money. I am sure I could do what ever needs to be done but first I need to know what needs to be done on my part.

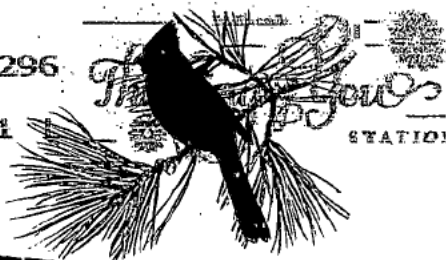
