I have not been threatened or promised any reward to make this statement.

I am 18 years old and I reside at [REDACTED]  
I have a 10TH grade education, and I can read and write.

ON HALLOWEEN MORNING, I WENT OVER TO FREDDIE OWENS . WE HAD BEEN TALKING ABOUT ROBBING A BANK. WE WENT TO THE NATIONS BANK ON AUGUSTA AND WHITE HORSE, BUT I COULDN'T DO IT SO WE LEFT. WE STARTED TALKING ABOUT STEALING A CAR AND GOING BACK TO ROB THE BANK AND THEN BURNING THE CAR AND GET IN ANOTHER CAR BUT WE DIDN'T DO THAT EITHER. WE DECIDED THAT WE DIDN'T HAVE ENOUGH PEOPLE TO ROB THE BANK SO WE WENT AND GOT KIKO VANCE AND "LITTLE MAN", WHO IS LESTER YOUNG. THEY WAS UP TO DOING IT WITH US, SO WE ALL GOT IN MY GRANDMOTHER'S CAR. IT'S A 1986 CHEVY. WE ALL WENT BACK TO THE BANK BUT WE STILL COULDN'T DO IT. FREDDIE AND KIKO STARTED TALKING ABOUT HITTING THE ANOTHONY'S JEWELRY STORE ON LAURENS ROAD. WE WENT OVER TO THE JEWELRY STORE AND SCOPED IT OUT WE GOT OUT AND FREDDIE PUT HIS MASK ON BUT THERE WAS A MAN SITTING IN A CAR THAT SAW US SO WE LEFT AND DIDN'T DO IT. WE LEFT THE JEWELRY STORE AND WE DECIDED TO HIT THE PRESTIGE CLEANERS \* PLEASANTBURG. ME AND LITTLE MAN WENT IN AND ROBBED IT. FREDDIE AND KIKO STAYED IN THE CAR. GOT OVER \$200.00. WE WAS DRESSED THE SAME WAY AS WHEN WE HIT THE SPEEDWAY. WE LEFT AND WENT BACK TO FREDDIE'S HOUSE AND COUNTED THE MONEY AND SPLIT IT UP. WE LEFT AND WENT TO A GAS STATION ON LAURENS ROAD BESIDE THE BOSTON MARKET. WE DIDN'T GET TO ROB IT BECAUSE THERE WAS TOO MANY CARS. WE LEFT THERE AND WENT TO THE WAFFLE HOUSE ON WHITE HORSE ROAD TO ROB IT BUT THERE WAS TOO MANY PEOPLE THERE AND THE POLICE HAD A CAR STOPPED DOWN THE ROAD. WE LEFT THERE AND WENT THE HOT SPOT ON AUGUSTA ROAD. ME, FREDDIE, AND LITTLE MAN WENT IN AND ROBBED IT. WE GOT OVER \$300.00. WE WENT TO FREDDIE HOUSE AND SPLIT THE MONEY. WE LEFT THERE AND IT WAS OVER IN THE MORNING. WE WENT TO THE RED ROOF INN AT I-85 AND LAURENS ROAD. I WENT IN AND GOT THE ROOM. I REGISTERED IN MY NAME. IT WAS ROOM 216 OR 218. WE DECIDED TO HIT THE SPPEEDWAY AND THE WAFFLE \* HOUSE AT THE SAME TIME. FREDDIE SAID WE WOULD SEE WHO COULD ROB THEIR PLACE THE FASTEST. ME AND FREDDIE WENT TO THE SPEEDWAY AND LITTLE MAN AND KIKO WENT TO THE WAFFLE HOUSE. THEY DIDN'T GET TO ROB IT BECAUSE IT WAS PACKED WITH PEOPLE. LITTLE MAN HAD ON JEANS AND A TOMMY HILFIGER SHIRT

THAT WAS BLUE AND TURNED INSIDE OUT, AND A LADY'S STOCKING MASK. KIKO HAD ON DARK BLUE NYLON PANTS AND A GRAY HOODED SWEATSHIRT AND A BLACK SKI MASK. FREDDIE HAD ON BLACK LEVI'S, BLACK NIKI SHIRT, BLACK NIKE JACKET WITH A WHITE CHECK, BROWN AND BLACK LUGAR SHOES AND A BLACK SKI MASK. I WAS WEARING BLACK NYLON PANTS, BLACK HOODED SWEATSHIRT, BLACK, WHITE, AND GRAY KIKE SHOES, AND A LADIES STOCKING MASK. ME AND FREDDIE WENT TO THE SPEEDWAY AND STOOD AROUND AND WATCHED IT FOR A MINUTE. THERE WAS A BIG WHITE TRUCK DRIVER WITH A BEARD THAT WENT IN. WHEN HE CAME OUT, WE WENT IN. I WENT IN THE DOOR FIRST AND WENT TO THE FRONT OF THE COUNTER. FREDDIE WENT BEHIND THE COUNTER. I HAD A .32 REVOLVER THAT HAS PART OF THE HANDLE MISSING THAT I HAD GOT FROM THE STREET. FREDDIE HAD A .32 REVOLVER THAT WAS SILVER WITH A BROWN HANDLE. I TOLD THE BLACK LADY BEHIND THE COUNTER TO OPEN THE REGISTER AND FREDDIE TOLD HER, TOO. WE GOT \$80.00 OUT OF THE FRONT REGISTER AND FREDDIE TOLD HER TO OPEN THE SAFE. SHE TOLD HIM THAT SHE COULDN'T BECAUSE IT WAS JAMMED. SHE TOLD HIM TO LOOK AT THE SAFE AND FREDDIE SAID, "OH, WELL". AND SHOT THE LADY IN THE HEAD. SHE KIND OF YELLED AND FELL ON THE FLOOR. I JUMPED BACK AND WE RAN OUT OF THE DOOR TOWARD LAURENS ROAD. WE HAD THE CAR PARKED BEHIND THE OLD RESTAURANT ACROSS THE STREET. WHILE WE WERE RUNNING, KIKO AND LITTLE MAN MET UP WITH US. FREDDIE SAID, "I SHOT THE LADY" FREDDIE GOT OUT AND TOOK HIS JACKET OFF. HE GAVE KIKO THE GUN, MASK, AND GLOVES FOR HIM TO HIDE. KIKO TOOK OFF RUNNING TO HIS HOUSE. WE WAITED THERE A FEW MINUTES AND THEN WENT TO MY HOUSE AND CHANGED CLOTHES. I GAVE FREDDIE A CHANGE OF CLOTHES AND HE LEFT THE ONE HE WAS WEARING AT MY HOUSE. I TOOK THEM BACK TO HIM THE NEXT DAY. I TOOK FREDDIE HOME FIRST, THEN LITTLE MAN, AND THEN I WENT TO THE MOTEL ROOM AND STAYED UNTIL CHECK OUT TIME. THE NEXT DAY I TOOK FREDDIE HIS SHOES AND BLACK PANTS HE WAS WEARING. FREDDIE TOLD ME TO KEEP MY MOUTH SHUT AND NOT TO SAY ANYTHING. HE SAID THE
