ORDER

Appellant move to proceed *in forma pauperis*. The right to proceed *in forma pauperis* must rest upon a statute or a fundamental constitutional right. *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). Appellant has the burden of showing her entitlement to this relief, but she has not done so. Therefore, Appellant's motion is denied. The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order. Failure to provide the filing fee will result in dismissal of the appeal.

On June 14, 2024, June 24, 2024, and July 31, 2024, Appellant filed motions to amend her appeal. It appears these documents were sent to correct deficiencies in Appellant's initial filing. It does not appear Appellant would like to amend her appeal to add or change an order on appeal or to alter the parties on appeal. Therefore, this court takes no action on Appellant's motions to amend her appeal.
