MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Wayne Hankinson respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, from September 20, 2024, until October 21, 2024**, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Wayne Hankinson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in The State v. Kadidas Gossett with the Court of Appeals on September 17, 2024. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Tony T. Sweet with the Court of Appeals on September 11, 2024. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Rodney Nesmith with the Court of Appeals on September 4, 2024. Counsel represented the appellant at his reconstruction hearing in The State v. Michael D. Williams before the circuit court on September 2, 2024. Counsel filed the Return to the Petition for Rehearing in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of James L. Williford with the Court of Appeals on August 23, 2024. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Maurice Anthony Odom v. State with the Supreme Court on August 22, 2024.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. On August 30, 2024, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through September 30, 2024.
