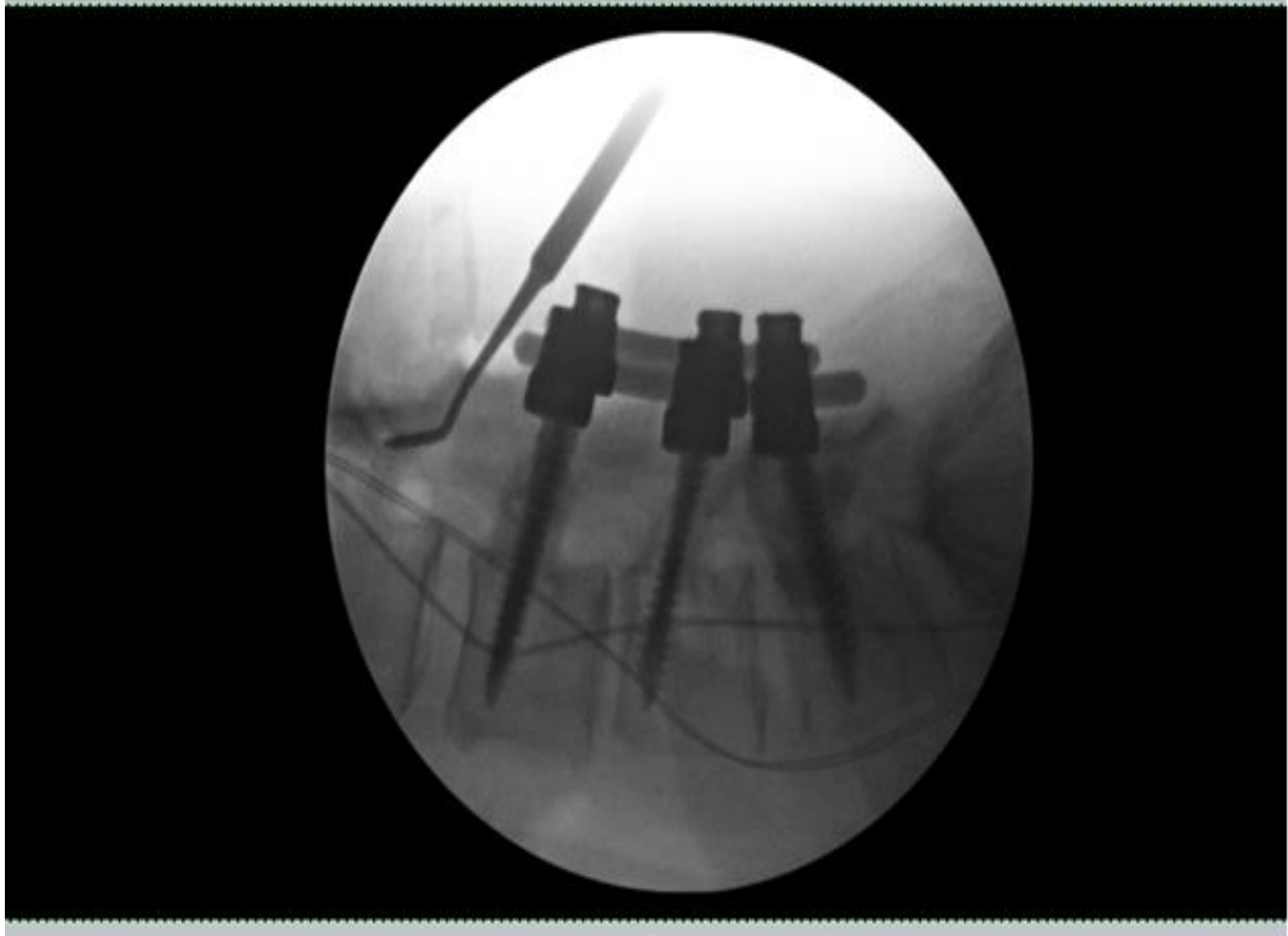
12. Docket cover sheet dated 9/5/2023 to reiterate the legitimately of the medical negligence and not medical malpractice intentions

My back had not made this type of change from the beginning of when I started having back issues.

17. Personal Letter to Respondents in regards to my knee failing still before my third surgery date 9/7/2020
18. Hospital bills and medical records pgs. 1-19 in upper right corner of page which is records from just a partial part of expenses as a direct causal to the gross negligence, which had been submitted prior to the lower court as well where I have fallen twice, with the latest fall in January 26, 2024; I suffered a broken hip and multiple other injuries. Hospital bills are paged 1-19 on right top corner.
