AFFIDAVIT OF Russell Lewis Walker

I, Russell Lewis Walker, being duly sworn, depose and say:

1. I am the appellant in the case number 2024-000643 currently before the South Carolina Court of Appeals.
2. I am seeking leave of court to file a Rule 60 motion for relief from judgment in the Circuit Court.
3. The grounds for my motion are as follows:

a. I was not given notice or an opportunity to be heard before the judge ~~she~~ she spontaneously issued a permanent restraining order against me violating my due process rights, and imposing a lifetime firearms ban. I have attached a copy of the permanent restraining order, texts between my attorney and I about the restraining order and an amended restraining order allegedly filed after I believe is fake or regardless lacking force and effect, the attachment is marked "Exhibit 1, page 1, of 8 pages" and is incorporated herein by reference.

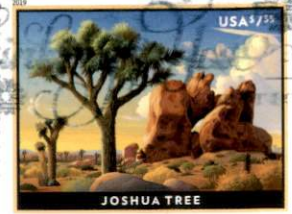
