Pursuant to 60(b)(4)(5) Rules of Civ. Pro.
Encompasses only Judgment from Court which
Failed to Provide Proper Due Process, or Judgment
from Courts which Lack Subject Matter Jurisdiction,
or Personal Jurisdiction.

Rule 60(b)(4) because a void judgment
is nullity and thus may be attacked at any time.

This rule does not limit the power of a
Court to entertain and independent action
to relieve a party from judgment, order or
proceeding, or to set aside a judgment for
fraud upon the court, during pendency of an
