DEAR COURT OF APPEALS

I IN REFERENCE TO YOUR LETTER DATED 19 SEP 2024 FOR APPELLATE CASE 2024-001571, WHICH IT APPLIES BENJAMIN MACK RECEIVED ON 19 SEP 2024, I DID NOT RECEIVE A COPY FROM MACK UNTIL YESTERDAY AFTERNOON (24 SEP 2024) ABOUT 1500, EFFECTIVELY MAKING IT IMPOSSIBLE FOR ME TO REPLY AND MY RESPONSE BEING DELIVERED TO THE COURT BY YOUR DEADLINE OF TOMORROW, 26 SEP 2024. I BELIEVE THIS STRATEGY WAS LIKELY INTENTIONAL.

CONSEQUENTLY, GIVEN MACK'S DELAY IN PROVIDING AND MY CURRENT UNRESOLVED MEDICAL ISSUES, PLEASE ACCEPT THIS LETTER AS AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND AND TO HOLD THIS CASE IN ABEYANCE PENDING A MOTION TO REMOVE MACK FOR AN ONGOING PATTERN OF INEFFECTIVE ASSISTANCE OF COUNSEL.

GIVEN MY CURRENT INABILITY TO GO INTO ALL OF THE DETAILS OF MACK, MS. MANAGER'S AND MY DISCUSSION YESTERDAY AFTERNOON, I WILL NOTE THAT MACK STATED SEVERAL THINGS AS TRUE, WHICH HE HAD TO KNOW WERE UNTRUE, AND REPEATEDLY REFUSED TO EXPLAIN WHY HE AND CAMERON BLAZER ALLOWED SCARLETT WILSON TO PUT CASES ON A TRIAL DOCKET THAT EVERYONE KNEW HAD NOT WENT THROUGH A SECOND APPEARANCE AND THEN WENT ALONG WITH MS. WILSON'S SCHEME TO HAVE ME ARRESTED FOR FAILING TO APPEAR FOR A CLEARLY IMPROPERLY SCHEDULED TRIAL OR TRIALS.

I TOOK MACK'S REPEATED REFUSAL TO EXPLAIN THEIR CONDUCT AS AN ADMISSION OF HIS/ THEIR CULPABILITY RELATED TO MY CURRENT INCARCERATION AND EXTREMELY DANGEROUS TRANSPORTATION BY CHARLESTON COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT OF ME FROM: NOT IN MY OWN TO THEM

SINCE I AM INCARCERATED AGAIN RELATED TO THE SAME UNDERLYING SCHEME AS THIS APPEAL, PLEASE ACCEPT THIS LETTER AS A REQUEST TO PUT THE APPEAL FILED 7 AUG 2024 ON HOLD / IN ABEYANCE THE CAPTION IS CHURCHILL PARK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC., MCCABE TROTTER + BEVERLY, CHURCHILL PARK, ETC. V. NORMA NIX, ESTATE OF NORMA NIX AND ALAN NIX V STATE STREET HOLDINGS.

I DELIVERED THE FIRST TRANSCRIPT LAST WEEK RIGHT BEFORE I WAS ARRESTED AGAIN AND STILL HAVEN'T HEARD ANYTHING ABOUT THE SECOND TRANSCRIPT. AS NOTED LAST WEEK, THE FIRST TRANSCRIPT DOES NOT APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN CORRECTED DESPITE AT LEAST TWO REQUESTS.

AS AN ASIDE, THERE ARE OBVIOUSLY NUMEROUS ISSUES WITH WHAT STRICKLAND, MCCABE TROTTER AND JUDGE NEWMAN DID AND DID NOT DO. IN MY OPINION, THERE IS A VERY HIGH CHANCE THE ORDER OF REFERRAL ITSELF IS A VOID. CONSEQUENTLY, THIS APPEAL NEEDS TO BE ALLOWED TO BE FULLY ADDRESSED WITHOUT ME BEING SUBJECT TO THE DURESS AND LACK OF ACCESS TO RESOURCES THAT THE COUNTY OF CHARLESTON HAS ONCE AGAIN KNOWINGLY IMPROPERLY SUBJECTED ME TO.
