ORDER

Appellant filed a notice of appeal challenging (1) an order denying its motions to confirm an arbitration order of dismissal and for an order dismissing the action with prejudice, and (2) an order denying its motion for reconsideration. Respondent moved to dismiss the appeal, arguing the orders on appeal are interlocutory and not immediately appealable. Appellant filed a return, opposing dismissal. Respondent filed a reply. After careful consideration, we deny Respondent's motion to dismiss without prejudice to the parties addressing the issue of appealability in their briefs.¹
