ORDER

Petitioner has moved to relieve counsel in this matter. By order dated August 13, 2024, in which we warned Petitioner of the dangers of self-representation, we advised Petitioner to notify this Court within twenty days whether he wishes to proceed *pro se* or continue to be represented by Sarah Shipe of the Division of Appellate Defense. Petitioner filed a response indicating he wishes to proceed *pro se*.

After careful consideration, the motion is denied. *See State v. Roberts*, 364 S.C. 583, 588–89, 614 S.E.2d 626, 629 (2005) (holding there is no right to proceed *pro se* on appeal, and the Court may, in its discretion, allow a petitioner to proceed *pro se*).
