PETITIONER'S WRITTEN OBJECTION TO SUPREME COURT'S ORDER

THIS MATTER COMES before the court upon the court's order dated on September 18, 2024. The order being to stricken the invoking of the Supreme Court's discretionary jurisdiction and the dismissal of the petitioner's matter.

The Petitioner hereby objects ~~and~~ in writing and states the following:

1. He is a prisoner in the custody of the Florida Department of Corrections with no access to South Carolina's Court Rules or Procedures.
2. When his Appeal was to be dismissed he filed an Petition invoking this court's discretionary jurisdiction as well as written objections to the Appeals court.
3. The Appeals court considered the written objections as a motion for rehearing and still denied it later on.
4. This court sent an order stating they couldn't get jurisdiction until the matter was settled by the South Carolina court of Appeals.
5. This court in that order did not state that certiorari had to be sought to get its jurisdiction invoked due to its statement ~~that~~ in the previous order.
6. Once the South Carolina court of Appeals made its ruling the Petitioner sought the Court's jurisdiction only to get it dismissed with the Order dated September 18, 2024 (See the enclosed order attached).

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner sends in these written objections and request that this court allows him to file for certiorari. Also the Petitioner requests ~~that~~ that this Court send him the Rule 242(d) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules so that he may be informed of how to file for certiorari because he is prose and does not have that information available to him in a Florida's Prison Law Library and the Law Clerks are unable to assist him with matters of South Carolina Court Rules and Procedures.
