MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Savayea Antwan Glenn respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension until November 12, 2024** in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Savayea Antwan Glenn respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. On October 10, 2024, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Sammie Lee Gerrick with the Court of Appeals. On October 4, 2024, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Steve Jones with the Court of Appeals. On September 30, 2024, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Omar Gentile v. The State with the Supreme Court. On September 23, 2024, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in Michael Orlando Brown v. The State with the Supreme Court. On September 16, 2024, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Roger Grate v. The State with the Supreme Court. On September 11, 2024, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Lontre Wise v. The State with the Supreme Court. On September 9, 2024, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Antonio Barnes with the Court of Appeals. On September 5, 2024, counsel filed the petition for rehearing in The State v. Nathaniel Rowland with the Court of Appeals.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


5. On September 29, 2024, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through October 31, 2024.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension until November 12, 2024** in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances.




