
NOTICE OF APPEAL





**MOTION TO CONTINUE
(REMAND BACK TO ADMINISTRATIVE
LAW COURT)**

This matter is brought before the South Carolina Court of Appeals, pursuant to an **Order of Dismissal**, by the Honorable Judge Ralph K. Anderson III on August 28, 2024. The South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce falsely stated that my Motion To Continue was not timely file, which is incorrect, as well as Appellant did not file a Notice of Appeal. 

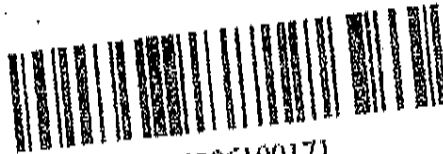


