Dear Ms. Kitchings:

On July 12, 2024, the Court issued a letter reminding all counsel and parties that the appeal would be held in abeyance pending resolution of the motion to dismiss the Appeal, which has now been denied without prejudice by order filed Sept. 3, 2024. In the Sept. 3, 2024 Order, the Court also provided 30 days for Respondents Janet P. Gochenour and Janet P. Gochenour Trustee to obtain counsel, which they have apparently not done. It further appears that even in view of the Hurricane Helene Orders making filing “holidays” of Sept. 27, and Sept. 30 through Oct. 4, as well as Oct. Oct. 7 to 9, 2024, the deadline for the Gochenour Respondents (initially Oct. 4, 2024) to obtain counsel has passed.

In the event our ‘calculations’ of the deadline are correct, Appellant would respectfully request that the deadlines for Respondents’ Initial Briefs be set in order to move this matter forward.
