This is a letter affidavit that states concerns I Robert Wayne Mitchell have regarding the appeal process and counsel Robert M. Dudek Representation in this matter.

On July 22, 2013, I recieved a copy of an Anders Brief Filed by Counsel Robert M. Dudek on my behalf with the South Carolina Court of Appeals. In addition to Counsel Dudek brief was a Letter informing me that the Court would write to me in the future eliciting any written memorandum I want to submit for the courts consideration of this Appeal.
