RULE 203 EXPLANATION OF ISSUE

As required by Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv), SCACR, undersigned counsel submits the following explanation of the issue that may be raised on appeal. Mr. Horton contends the circuit court erred in denying him credit for time served prior to sentencing pursuant to Section 24-13-40(3) of the South Carolina Code, which provides that "credit for time served prior to trial and sentencing shall not be given: . . . when the prisoner commits a subsequent crime while out on bond."

Mr. Horton argues that the statute violates the Double Jeopardy and Due Process Clauses of both the United States and South Carolina Constitutions. By depriving Mr. Horton of credit for pretrial detention toward his sentence, the statute constitutes multiple punishments for the same offense. Furthermore, even if the statutory provision is constitutionally valid, statutory construction would dictate that the credit for pretrial detention shall not be given on the first offense, not the second offense.
