Dear Counsel:

This responds to your *pro se* motion entitled motion for reconsideration. No action will be taken on this motion for three reasons.

First, you are represented by counsel in this matter. Therefore, you may not file a *pro se* motion of this nature. *Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010); *Jones v. State*, 348 S.C. 13, 558 S.E.2d 517 (2002); *State v. Stuckey*, 333 S.C. 56, 508 S.E.2d 564 (1998); *Foster v. State*, 298 S.C. 306, 379 S.E.2d 907 (1989).

Second, since this Court denied the petition for a writ of certiorari to review the decision of the Court of Appeals under Rule 242 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), no petition for rehearing is permitted. Rule 221(a), SCACR ("No petition for rehearing shall be allowed from an order denying a petition for a writ of certiorari under Rule 242, SCACR.").

Third, the South Carolina Court of Appeals sent the remittitur in the case on July 18, 2013. Rule 221(b), SCACR ("If a petition for writ of certiorari is filed, the

Court of Appeals shall not send the remittitur until notified that the petition has been denied."). The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case and no further motion can be considered by this Court. *Wise v. South Carolina Department of Corrections*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007).
