Issue on Appeal:

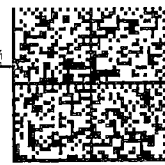
- I did not receive time credit due to laws changing after my arrest
- Crime was committed under old law conditions, new law came into affect after arrest and did not receive the time credit.

I was arrested on June 11 2023. on July 26 2023 the Judge revoked my bond. I was sentenced to 5 years in SCDC on Sept. 5 2024. After accepting the plea agreement, the Judge was doing his sentencing and the solicitor stated I would not get the 15 months time credited to my sentence due to laws changing in July. The solicitor stated that the laws changed in July and the new law was that my bond got revoked and i would not receive time credit. The crimes were committed and i was charged before the laws changed. I should be grandfathered under the old law. I was under the impression I was getting the 15 months i did in county toward my sentence. My lawyer never advised me that i was not

getting that time credited to my sentence. My lawyer and the judge was unaware of the new law. During court the judge had to take a recess so that the solicitor could search for the new law and show it to the judge so that he did not give me the credited time.
