I am in receipt of the letter that you recently sent to Attorney Joshua A. Bailey. My Wife hired Attorney Bailey back in March. He has failed to represent me. 
* Please notice the letter from the Clerk of Court once she received the Documents proving that my Attorney stole the restitution. She apologized.

December 12, 2011: At approximately 0930 hours I attempted to make contact with the victim at telephone number 442-0414 regarding this case. I was unable to speak with the victim at that time and I left her a detailed voicemail message regarding the status of this investigation.


 **December 12, 2011:** At approximately 0935 hours the victim returned my phone call regarding this case. I provided her with an update regarding the status of this investigation. I advised her that I am waiting to hear back from the subject's attorney. I advised her that I would contact her with any new developments regarding this case.

December 12, 2011: At approximately 1005 hours I attempted to make contact with the subject's attorney at telephone number 899-5111 regarding this case. I was informed that he was not currently in the office due to being at a hearing. I left my name and telephone number and advised him to have him contact me as soon as possible regarding this case.

December 14, 2011: At approximately 1555 hours I made contact with the Kears Law Firm regarding this case. They informed me that Mr. Kears was currently in General Sessions and was unavailable. I left a message for him at that time regarding this case.

 **December 14, 2011:** At approximately 1650 hours Kevin Kears made contact with me by telephone regarding this case. He informed me that his client is getting the money together to pay restitution to the Arnolds. Mr. Kears further stated that his client will surrender himself to law enforcement on 12/20/2011. I advised him to contact me with any changes to this appointment. I also provided Mr. Kears with my fax number so he could send me documents regarding this case.

December 16, 2011: At approximately 1613 hours I made contact with the victim at telephone number 442-0414 regarding this case. I provided the victim with an update regarding the status of this investigation. I further informed her that the subject is scheduled to turn himself into law enforcement on 12/20/2011. I advised her that I would contact her with any new developments in this case.

 **December 20, 2011:** At approximately 0908 hours the Kears Law firm made contact with me by telephone regarding this case. They informed me that they had to make a change to the appointment. They stated that they would be able to meet with me on 12/22/2011 at approximately 1300 hours to surrender. They stated that the subject has paid his attorney the money needed to pay the victim for restitution. I advised them to contact me with any other changes to this appointment.

December 20, 2011: At approximately 1250 hours I made contact with the victim at telephone number 442-0414 regarding this case. I advised her of the new developments with this case. I advised her that I would contact her once I obtained any new information.

December 21, 2011: On this date I received a fax from the Kears Law Firm regarding this case. This fax containing documents showing where the subject, William Cokley, purchased a 2006 Ford Focus bearing VIN

1FAFP34N26W16W164410. The bill of sale (#4552918) shows that the subject purchased that vehicle from US Auto Sale of Summerville at 10453 Hwy 78 in Summerville SC on October 28, 2011. They also provided me with a receipt where the subject paid \$1,050.00 on October 27, 2011. *I noted that the bill of sale shows that the subject purchased the vehicle on October 28, 2011, but the handwritten receipt shows that he paid on October 27, 2011.*

I attached this information to the case file for future reference.

December 22, 2011: At approximately 1145 hours I met with Ivan Huntley at 10453 Hwy 78 in Summerville (Johnsons Used Auto Parts) regarding this case. He informed me that he is also the owner of US Auto Sales of Summerville. I then inquired about the transaction with William Cokley on October 28, 2011 under bill of sale #4552918. Mr. Huntley informed me that William Cokley did purchase a Silver in color 2006 Ford Focus bearing VIN 1FAFP34N26W164410. Mr. Huntley stated that William Cokley purchased the vehicle for approximately \$1,050.00. Mr. Huntley further stated that the vehicle in question was a non running vehicle. Mr. Huntley stated that they kept the motor, transmission, wheels and tires from the vehicle that Mr. Cokley purchased. Mr. Huntley stated that he knows the vehicle was a 2006 but he could not remember the number of doors on the vehicle or the color of the vehicle. Mr. Huntley confirmed that the VIN on the vehicle sold to Mr. Cokley was the VIN indicated on the bill of sale. Mr. Huntley stated that William Cokley has not purchased any other Ford Focus sedans from him.


I then obtained written statements from Mr. Huntley and Robert Smith Jr. regarding this transaction.


Mr. Smith provided a written statement since he was the one who handled the transaction with William Cokley. Mr. Smith also confirmed that the vehicle that Mr. Cokley purchased was not in running condition when it was purchased. Mr. Smith also stated that he confirmed the VIN was the same on the vehicle and the bill of sale.

Mr. Huntley then provided me with a copy of the bill of sale, certificate of title, warranty and a copy of the SCDL for William Cokley that they obtained at the time of the transaction.

I noted that the State of SC Certificate of Title of a Vehicle shows that the vehicle sold to William Cokley was a 2006 Ford Focus 4 door sedan bearing VIN 1FAFP34N26W164410.

I provided Mr. Huntley and Mr. Smith their copies of the written statements regarding this case. I also provided Mr. Huntley with my business card and advised him to contact me with any new information regarding this case.

 **December 22, 2011:** At approximately 1330 hours the subject, William Cokley, and his attorney, Kevin Kearse, met with me at the CID office regarding this case. I then met with the subject and his attorney in our conference room. Mr. Kearse stated that Mr. Cokley would not be making a statement to law enforcement regarding this case. I then served the subject with his three arrest warrants (M-472508, M-472515 and M-



472516) in the presence of his attorney in our conference room. I then completed the warrant indicating that it had been served and I provided the subject with his copies. I then completed booking form for the subject. The subject provided his money to his attorney and he kept his SCDL on his person for the booking process.

I then took the subject into custody and escorted him to the DCSO Jail Annex. At the DCSO Jail Annex, I booked the subject in under the aforementioned arrest warrants. I provided the staff at the DCSO Jail Annex with the original warrants, booking report, bond request form and victim's notification forms for these charges. I turned custody of the subject over to the staff at the DCSO Jail Annex without incident.

December 22, 2011: At approximately 1415 hours I made contact with Edward Bridges (AKA "EB") at Mike Reichenbach Ford/Lincoln/Mercury, telephone number 843-664-4141, regarding this case. I advised him of the subject's arrest. He informed me that they would be sending someone to the subject's bond hearing to represent their business as a victim in this case. I provided him with my contact information and advised him to contact me with any new information regarding this case. I further advised him that they would be notified of any court proceedings from here on out.

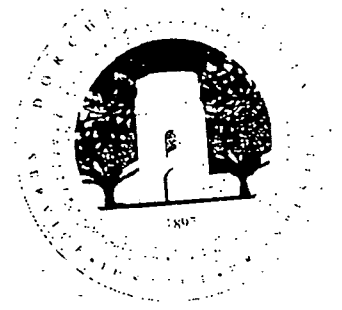
December 22, 2011: At approximately 1420 hours I made contact with Rhonda Arnold at telephone number 442-0414 regarding this case. I advised her of the subject's arrest in this case. I further advised her that she would be contacted by the DCSO Jail to inform her of the date and time for the subject's bond hearing. She advised me that she would be present for the subject's bond hearing. I advised her that she would be notified of any court proceedings from here on out. I advised her to contact me with any new information or questions regarding this case.

December 22, 2011: At approximately 1425 hours I made contact with the DCSO Dispatch Center regarding this case. I advised them of the subject's arrest and had them remove him from NCIC.

December 29, 2011: At approximately 1059 hours I obtained a title history for VIN 1FAFP34N26W164410 (On Dash of Vehicle) through the SCDMV. I attached this information to the case file for future reference.

December 29, 2011: This case is Cleared by Arrest since the subject, William L. Cokley, has been located and served with the arrest warrants in this case. On 12/22/2011 I (Detective A. Smith) served the subject with arrest warrants M-472508 (Chop Shop - Sell Vehicle with Altered VIN), M-472515 (Selling of a Stolen Vehicle) and M-472516 (Obtaining Money Under False Pretenses >\$2,000 but <\$10,000) and booked him into the DCSO Jail Annex. In addition, it was determined that the incident location was 610 N Magnolia Street in Summerville, which is also located in Dorchester County. Also Mike Reichenbach Ford/Lincoln/Mercury is a victim in this case since the vehicle was stolen from their dealership in Florence, SC (Florence PD OCA 2011-011377). I have no further information to report at this time.

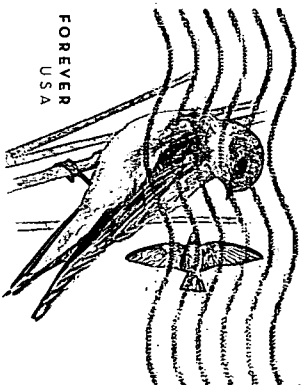

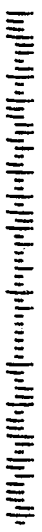
