ORDER

This is an appeal from the trial court's denial of Appellant's motion for a new trial pursuant to Rule 29(b) of the South Carolina Rules of Criminal Procedure. Appellant's counsel has filed a motion to be relieved, explaining he was not retained to handle the appeal. Respondent filed a return, taking no position on counsel's withdrawal. Appellant has filed a pro se motion to appoint counsel and motion to vacate judgment.

Counsel's motion to relieve counsel is granted. Appellant has thirty days to obtain new counsel, or this Court will presume Appellant is proceeding pro se. Appellant's motions are denied.
