Mr. Roberts petitioned this court for a Writ of Certiorari, dated 9-10-24, in order that this court may compel the PCR court to comply with section 17-27-80. In response, I received correspondence from you dated "September 18, 2024", stating "This Court has received your petition for a writ of certiorari, which is being construed as a notice of appeal". After this, I responded by submitting "A Notice of Appeal" and referenced Rule 62, of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure mistakenly; and included with this "Amended notice" a motion for summary judgment (which I wish to be heard on). In a Petition for a Writ of Mandamus dated Sept. 23, 2024 I attempted to have this court compel the PCR courts compliance with section 17-27-80; to issue an order to Leah Guerry Dupree (Clerk) to allow me to have "filed" my belated Rule 59(e) and to accept my prose filings; and to acknowledge and announce the violation of Rule 60 of the Circuit Courts by Judge McCay's appointment of "standby counsel" Denise Swape. As of this writing Denise Swape, Leah Guerry Dupree, or Danielle Dixon has not responded to my Petition for a Writ of Mandamus dated Sept. 23, 2024. Without any construction to the relief I'm asking I state that I have been denied due process to Appellate review

by the non-compliance of the PCR Court with statutory law relating to § 17-27-80; denied under the governing limitations to submit a Rule 59(e) by Leah Guerny Dupree because of Denise Swope's "misrepresentation of a material fact" (Posing as Mr. Roberts counsel and she is not).

The relief I'm seeking is an order issued to the PCR court to comply with § 17-27-80; I'm seeking an order issued to Leah Guerny Dupree to comply with her ministerial duty and allow Mr. Roberts to have ~~been~~ filed his belated Rule 59(e); and to be heard on his Motion for Summary Judgment; and I'm seeking an order to compel Denise Swope to cease & desist any involvement with my case. I'm asking that my "Petition for Writ of Certiorari" be granted that My right to Appellate review be restored. "See Petition for Writ of Certiorari" dated 9-10-24
