

REASON FOR AFFIANT'S BELIEF THAT THE  
PROPERTY SOUGHT IS ON THE SUBJECT PREMISES

On August 18, 2018 police began an investigation into a homicide that occurred at 4591 Hwy 19 in the Conway section of Horry County. During the incident, two victims were shot and succumbed to their injuries. During the investigation, it was determined that one of the victim's vehicle was missing and presumed that the suspect(s) stole the vehicle after the fact. The vehicle was located approximately 100 yards from the intersection of Cookes Circle and Hwy 917 in the Nichols section of Horry County. The vehicle had been abandoned and set on fire. It is my belief that a search of cellphone towers in the area of both crimes will assist with identifying individuals who were in the same areas at the times of both the homicide and the vehicle fire, which based on the distance between the crimes would be very suspicious.
