


The State filed a petition for rehearing. Dennis filed a motion to strike the petition, arguing it violated the page restriction in Rule 221 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. The State thereafter filed an amended petition for rehearing in compliance with the rule. Because the State's amended petition complies with the rule, we decline to act on the motion to strike because it is now moot. After careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the Court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied. The attached opinion is substituted for the previous opinion, which is withdrawn.
