
Dear Ms. Hill:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, you must provide a proof of service that states that a copy of your notice of appeal has been timely served on each respondent or their counsel.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The filing fee amount submitted is incorrect. The correct filing fee is \$250.00. We are returning your check, number 6123, to you along with this letter.
- The argument provided as part of your notice of appeal cannot be considered at this time. The notice of appeal should be substantially in the format shown

by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. The notice of appeal must also clarify who each respondent is in this appeal.
