

## ORDER

---

On August 9, 2024, this court granted a temporary stay and remanded the case to the circuit court for a hearing on Appellant's motion to stay and determination of any appeal bond. On August 30, 2024, Appellant informed this court that she appeared before the circuit court on August 16, 2024, and was told to continue to pay her rent. Subsequently, this court requested Appellant provide a copy of the circuit court's order on the motion to stay and determination of an appeal bond. Appellant informed this court that the circuit court had not issued a written order. A review of the public index confirmed the circuit court had not issued a written order.

On October 29, 2024, Appellant filed a second motion to stay because the magistrate issued a writ of ejectment on October 24, 2024. We vacate the October 24, 2024 writ of ejectment because this court's temporary stay issued on August 9, 2024, remains in effect until the circuit court issues an order on the motion to stay and determination of an appeal bond. Additionally, this case was remanded for the limited purpose of hearing the motion to stay and setting any appeal bond. *See* Rule 205, SCACR ("Upon the service of the notice of appeal, the appellate court shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the appeal . . ."). Finally, we direct the circuit court to issue a written order on Appellant's motion to stay and request for an appeal bond.
