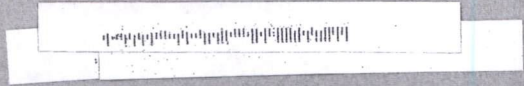

Respondent contentions that "failure to accept Plaintiffs timely submitted Rule 59(e) prose motions" was based on S.C. Code Ann. § 14-7-1630-1640. The Plaintiff submits that the Respondent's motion is unfounded both in fact and at law. Contrary to Respondent's contentions "The South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure apply to postconvictions matters. S.C. R. Civ. P. 71.1(A).

PCR court is not in accordance with trial court's [Statutory] obligation to render findings and conclusions on each issue duly raised in application for postconviction relief. See Plaintiffs "Petition for A Writ of Certiorari" dated 9-10-24; See also, Plaintiffs "Petition for A Writ of Mandamus dated 9-23-24 (Emphasis). Accordingly, Mr. Roberts ask that the Writs be issued to compell compliance with PCR courts statutory obligation and issue an order allowing Mr. Roberts "belated" filing of his prose Rule 59(e) motions as his initial attempts to do so was timely...
