

ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order of the circuit court vacating its oral judgment as improvidently granted. The order on appeal also denies the appellant's motion to appoint trustees and service and motion requesting a W-9 form. The appeal is dismissed as not immediately appealable. *See* S.C. Code Ann. §14-3-330 (2017) (defining appellate jurisdiction); *Serowski v. Serowski*, 381 S.C. 306, 315, 672 S.E.2d 589, 594 (Ct. App. 2009) (holding a court has discretion to modify or amend a prior oral ruling, including the ability to issue a written order which is in conflict with the oral ruling). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
