SECOND MOTION TO EXTEND TRANSCRIPT ORDER DEADLINE

The Petitioner, Cyntonio Howard, by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully requests this Court to extend the deadline for the PCR hearing transcript to be ordered.

This extension is requested for purposes of allowing Mr. Howard additional time to acquire other private appellate counsel or SCCID services. He has been sent the SCCID Affidavit of Indigency, NOA, as well as a letter with instructions. Additionally, Undersigned Counsel was not retained to perfect his PCR appeal, in addition to outstanding legal fees, and Mr. Howard has been advised that we would not be serving as appellate counsel.
