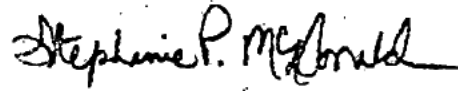

ORDER

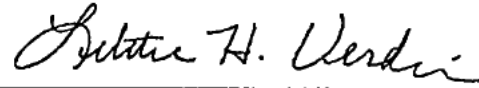
