MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE

Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Tony T. Sweet with the Court of Appeals on September 11, 2024. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Rodney Nesmith with the Court of Appeals on September 4, 2024. Counsel appeared on behalf of appellant at a Reconstruction Hearing in the case of The State v. Michael D. Williams on September 2, 2024.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On October 31, 2024, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously


