On November 5, the Court advised the parties that oral argument in this matter had been set for December 4, 2024.

When the Court advised counsel to disclose potential conflicts during the week of December 2 (which was by letter dated August 21), the undersigned did not have any. However, since that time, the undersigned has been called to what will be at least a two-week jury trial commencing on December 2 in federal court in Greenville. Clear Touch Interactive, Inc. v. The Ockers Co. et al., 6:21-cv-02208 (D.S.C.). There have been no productive settlement discussions between the parties, and none are anticipated. Consequently, the undersigned counsel for Appellant anticipates that trial will commence as scheduled on December 2, which would present a conflict with the proposed December 4 scheduling date. Rule 601(b), SCACR, would suggest that oral argument in the Fast Formliners case should be rescheduled.
