

ORDER

On October 8, 2024, Respondent moved to dismiss this appeal. After careful consideration, we deny Respondent's motion to dismiss.

On August 29, 2024, this court issued an order denying Appellant's request for this court to issue a subpoena to the Lexington County Sheriff's Department to furnish Respondent's "confession video and voluntary statement." On October 11, 2024, Appellant again requested this court issue a subpoena to the Lexington County Sheriff's Department for Respondent's "confession video and written voluntary statement." We take no action on Appellant's October 11, 2024 motion because this court's August 29, 2024 order did not end or finally decide the appeal. *See* Rule 221(c), SCACR ("The appellate court will not entertain petitions for rehearing on a motion or petition unless the action of the court on the motion or petition has the effect of dismissing or finally deciding a party's appeal.").
