## ORDER

On September 9, 2024, Respondent filed a motion to dismiss, arguing Appellant "failed to argue or identify the appealable errors and failed to identify any documents . . . to expose any error on behalf of the lower court." Appellant filed a return. After careful consideration, we deny Respondent's motion. However, we strike Appellant's amended initial brief. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file a second amended initial brief that complies with this court's rules. Specifically, the second amended initial brief shall include "references to the transcript, pleadings, orders, exhibits, or other materials which may be properly included in the Record on Appeal [see Rule 210(c)] to support the salient facts alleged."
