The mere fact that this document was filed on the 17th, at 2:10 PM on the 18th makes it physically impossible for to be put in the mail and delivered within 24 hours to give the recipient time to prepare for hearing, the court would have allowed sufficient time to the mail to reach the other people of record in the filing by doing the filing and assigning in less than 24 hours is an impossibility. There could not have been any notification of any kind.

Over the past four years. All of the other judges dismissed it. It is a legal maneuver to win a case, I pray that the powers that be would review the case. See the maneuvers that have been used to try to steal the property and to avoid a trial. We have already to bring our case to court. I prayerfully ask that you set aside and investigate those that put forth this motion before the court and the judge that signed it so quickly. Knowing it was less than 24 hours that even the documents said clearly that everyone had to be notified. Please reverse the decision that we may receive a fair and just verdict in this case

We pray that the court will stay the summary judgment and to allow the court to move forward with the trial.
