## ORDER

---

This appeal initially arose from Appellant's attempt to appeal an order of release/discharge entered by the circuit court. Because such a bond order is not immediately appealable, this court dismissed the appeal on August 12, 2024.

Appellant filed a motion to reinstate on August 26, 2024, followed by a motion to amend his notice of appeal on September 21, 2024, and a "Motion for Clarification under S.C. App. Ct. R. 240" on October 30, 2024. Because a bond order is not immediately appealable, we deny the motion to reinstate as to this order and we likewise deny the "Motion for Clarification."

However, Appellant's September 21, 2024 motion seeks to amend his notice of appeal to include an appeal of the circuit court's September 16, 2024 order of contempt. We grant the motion to reinstate the appeal as to the order of contempt only. Appellant must file and serve a copy of the September 16, 2024 order of contempt within 10 days of the date of this order or this appeal will be dismissed.

To the extent Appellant complies with this order and with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules in perfecting his appeal, he may raise his arguments related to the bond order in his briefing addressing the order of contempt.
