THE FEDERAL COURTS SEIZED THE WEAPON ATF SPECIAL AGENT JESSE LEE CASE # 3:13-967 RATHEL TOOK POSSESSION ON JANUARY 7, 2013. PETITIONER WAS INDICTED FOR UNLAWFUL CARRYING OF A PISTOL ON FEBRUARY 20, 2013 AND SENTENCE ON APRIL 9, 2013. THEREFORE THE STATE LACKED JURISDICTION OVER THE CASE.
