2. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Tyquez Brisbane v. State with the Supreme Court on November 21, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v.


Rachel Wilcox with the Court of Appeals on November 14, 2024. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Albert Siders v. State with the Supreme Court on November 6, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Angel Ibarra with the Court of Appeals on October 31, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Travis D. Bryant with the Court of Appeals on October 21, 2024. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Carly Blumenstein v. State with the Supreme Court on October 18, 2024. Counsel attended the annual South Carolina Public Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina from October 14-16, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Xavier M. Washington with the Court of Appeals on October 3, 2024. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of State v. James E. Daniels, Jr. with the Supreme Court on October 2, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Robert A. Wheeler with the Court of Appeals on September 16, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Brian Nesbitt with the Court of Appeals on September 16, 2024.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that her caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

4. On October 31, 2024, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through November 30, 2024.


