**RESPONDENT’S FIRST MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE PETITION FOR REHEARING**

Pursuant to 240(a), SCACR, Respondent Gibbs International, Inc. (“Respondent”) respectfully requests an extension of time of fifteen (15) days within which to file Respondent’s Petition for Rehearing.

The Court issued its opinion in this appeal on **Wednesday, November 13, 2024**. Pursuant to Rule 221(a), SCACR, Respondent’s deadline to file a Petition for Rehearing is **Monday, December 2, 2024**. (Fifteen days from November 13, 2024 is Thursday, November 28, 2024, which is Thanksgiving Day. Since Thursday, November 28, 2024 and Friday, November 29, 2024 are Court holidays, the deadline rolls forward to Monday, December 2, 2024.)

WHEREFORE, Respondent respectfully requests the Court issue an order granting its request for an extension of fifteen (15) days to file their Petition for Rehearing, up to and including **Tuesday, December 17, 2024.**
